POLICY ON WASTE MANAGEMENT

We, at Titiksha Public School, are dedicated to Reduce, Reuse and Recycle! The aim is to minimize the waste production in the school campus. A number of initiatives have been taken to achieve this mission, as mentioned below:

- Waste is collected, processed and disposed off in accordance with the standards laid down by the pollution control board.
- Students and staff members are motivated and guided to reduce paper waste. Students use both sides ruled notebooks for their writing work. They use their unfinished notebooks for holidays' homework and practice work.
- Rules promoting waste management are mentioned in the school Link Book.
- We emphasize on segregation of waste into different categories. The school also makes best efforts to spread awareness about E-waste, its collection and safe disposal.

Titiksha Public School is associated with **Chintan** for E-waste recycling. Their mission is now our responsibility to safeguard the environment and also to bring awareness to what technology can do so that the students adopt technology for their benefit.

Proportioned meals are given to students in the Mom's Kitchen to minimize food wastage. Additional food is given only on demand / need.
