






COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS

Without mathematics, there's nothing you can do. Everything around you is Mathematics. Everything around you is numbers.


Geometry is a branch of mathematics that deals with the measurement, properties and relationships of points, lines, angles, surfaces and solids.
