#### **TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT**


#### "Learning is an ongoing process."


## **GREEN WRITING GALA**

Cyber fraud can happen when hackers use techniques like phishing, where they pretend to be a trusted entity to get your financial information.

#### How to Stay Safe from Financial Cyber Fraud: Key Tips

**1. Guard Personal Information:** Don't share personal details like your name, address, or passwords without checking with a trusted adult.
